



Healdsburg High School Athletic Hall of Fame By-Laws

Purpose

To recognize and pay tribute for outstanding athletic achievement, coaching or service to Healdsburg High School (HHS), since its inception in 1888.

Hall of Fame Committee Composition

1. The committee shall consist of at least seven individuals including a Steve Hockert Foundation representative.
2. Current and retired employees of the Healdsburg Unified School District, along with members of the community shall be eligible to serve on the committee.
3. The High School Athletic Director, or his/her designate, shall serve as a committee member.

Criteria for Selection to the Hall of Fame

A nominee becomes eligible for consideration if:

1. An athlete, ten years after graduation HHS.
2. A coach, three years after termination of primary coaching duties
3. A person who does not meet point one or two but has contributed to the support of Healdsburg athletics.
4. Nominees must have made a significant and distinguishing contribution to Healdsburg athletics in one or more sports. Nomination form should include significant accomplishments, honors received, letters earned and highlights, both during and after high school as applicable.
5. Nominees must have distinguished themselves with a high degree of character throughout their high school, post high school, and adult lives.

Nomination and Selection Process

1. Committee members may nominate any athlete, coach or support personnel.
2. Nominations from the public shall be solicited each year through notices in the local media and school district publications. The HHS Athletic Director will accept nominations. Nominations will be accepted anytime, although the Hall of Fame Committee will only review nominations received prior to Oct 1st each year.
3. Nominations will be screened at scheduled Committee meetings.
4. The Committee will select up to 4 inductees each year.
5. Between July 1st and October 1st of each school year, the Hall of Fame Committee will screen nominees, and the final selection shall take place by October 10th of that year.
6. Nominations are permanent. Once a nomination is received, they do not have to be re-submitted other than updating their file with current or new information.

Formal Induction

1. Inductees will be formally introduced at the annual REIBT Tournament in December. The inductees will be introduced between the two HHS games on Friday night of REIBT.
2. There will be an induction Ceremony on the Sunday after REIBT to properly honor Hall of Fame inductees. The Ceremony shall be open to the public. Fees to attend and take part in the Ceremony are the responsibility of those in attendance. The Hall of Fame Committee will pay for the cost of the inductee and a guest to attend the Ceremony.
3. Each inductee shall receive an award recognizing their contribution to HHS athletics. There will also be a permanent plaque that will be appropriately displayed in the high school.
4. All Hall of Fame costs will be generated by non-HHS funds and managed by the Steve Hockert Memorial Foundation. The Hall of Fame Committee is responsible for soliciting donations to cover any and all costs associated with the Hall of Fame.
5. Unless an inductee has passed away or is physically unable to ever attend the ceremony, inductees who are unable to attend the year they are selected will be inducted the following year based on their availability. This change will not impact or change the number of members inducted in either year.
